ELIGIBILITY: Any bowler who holds a C5PBA membership card and is at least nineteen (19) years of age as of December 31, 2017 may participate. Bowlers are required to purchase a C5PBA membership card if they have not purchased one in a league. The cost of a C5PBA card is \$16.00 if paid before October 31st, 2017, and \$20.00 if paid after that date.

PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP: The top 9 ladies and top 9 men will advance to the provincial championship as the men's, ladies, and mixed teams representing Thunder Bay from March 28 – 31, 2018 at Whitewater Lanes in Azilda, ON. The top three men and ladies will make up the singles. All bowlers will be responsible for the tournament fee set by NO5PBA, full hotel cost, and will be required to sell four (4) Northern Ontario Lottery tickets or forfeit their spot on the team. Bowlers will receive a small travel allowance paid for a maximum of six (6) vehicles.

I agree to abide by the Dress Code and any other rules set by the Thunder Bay District 5 Pin Bowlers' Association and the Northern Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association at any further competitions evolving from this Zone Roll-Off.

WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY: The Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers Association, the Northern Ontario 5-Pin Bowlers Association, the Thunder Bay District 5-Pin Bowlers Association, and the Host committee undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the competitors. Entry Form- Rules and Regulations
(PLEASE READ ALL CAREFULLY)

ENTRY DEADLINE: Midnight on Wednesday, January 24, 2018. Late entries will be accepted only to fill the lane draw.

ROLL-OFFS: Saturday, January 27, 2018 – Seven (7) games at Galaxy Lanes, starting at 4:30PM
Saturday, January 27, 2018 – Three (3) games at Mario's Bowl starting at 8:30PM

Sunday, January 28, 2018 – Four (4) games at Mario's Bowl starting at 10:00AM
Sunday, January 28, 2018 – Six (6) games at Superior Bowladrome starting at 1:00PM

TOURNAMENT FEE: \$160.00 (including lineage). Fee may be paid along with this entry form, online through our website (www.tbd5pba.ca) or on the day of the tournament (Cash, Money Order, Visa, and MasterCard accepted)

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all bowlers who hold a C5PBA membership card and have reached the age of nineteen (19) as of December 31st, 2017.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Bowlers will change position each game (i.e. 1st will move to last and all other move up one position)
2. The first bowler must not start their next frame until all bowlers on the opposite lane have completed their frame.
3. Any complaints of interference or any other nature should be registered with the Judge of Play immediately.
4. Bowlers are not permitted to catch up for missed frames. Bowlers entering a game late will receive a score of zero for missed frames.
5. Bowlers will change lanes each game, with odd lanes moving left and even lanes moving right.
6. Bowlers will be responsible for resetting and clearing their own lanes and may not do so for another bowler.
7. Bowlers who display unsportsmanlike behavior and abusive conduct as defined in the C5PBA rulebook will receive one warning. Second offence will result in disqualification. The definitions are found below.
8. Any bowler whose wearing apparel is deemed by the judge of play to be obscene by picture or printed word will be disqualified from further play.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT (Section D, Rule 5, Part B)

Unsportsmanlike conduct shall be defined as, but not limited to:

- Using the balls as an expression of emotion by bouncing the ball or striking other balls on the rack
- Throwing balls in an extreme lofting manner in an underhand or overhand motion
- Loud and abusive language
- Using part of one's body members in such expression of emotion as; kicking of ball racks or other establishment equipment, throwing of furniture or other establishment equipment, striking of walls, posts, etc

ABUSIVE CONDUCT (Section D, Rule 5, Part C)

Participants shall not display abusive conduct toward officials during events. Abusive conduct shall be defined as, but not limited to:

- Being disrespectful toward and official.
- Using profanity when addressing officials.
- Being loud and aggressive when addressing officials.

- Use of intimidation tactics.

REPEAT OFFENDERS – Participants who are reported to the Provincial Association on two or more separate occasions, shall be liable for suspension of membership.

OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All C5PBA rules will be in effect for this tournament.
2. The top three men and top three ladies, after 20 games, will represent Thunder Bay as the singles entrants at the Provincial Championship
3. The next three men and three ladies, after 20 games, along with the singles entrants, will make up the men's and ladies' teams advancing to the Provincial Championship
4. The next three men and three ladies, after 20 games, will make up the mixed team advancing to the Provincial Championships
5. In the event of a tie for 1st, 3rd, 6th, and 9th positions, one complete game must be bowled to determine final placing.
6. Coaches will be chosen by the bowlers (or the TBD5PBA Executive, if necessary), directly after the event. Coaches must hold their Competitive Coach certification and be certified a minimum of 30 days prior to the Provincial Championships. They must also be a current member of the C5PBA in good standing.
